CONSIDER TAKING THE FOLLOWING ACTION ON AGENDA ITEMS:

- 1) APPROVE Non-Reimbursable Agreement for Relocation of Utility Facilities on Public Right-of-Way with Alabama Power Company, for Project MCR-2022-102, Chickasaw Streets - Grade, Drain, Base, and Pave (GDBP). There is no cost to Mobile County for this relocation, requested by the Engineering Department.
- 2) APPROVE the updated Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Plan (FY 2023) for the Jeremiah A. Denton Airport, in accord with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT), 49 CFR Part 26, requested by the Engineering Department.
- 3) APPROVE preliminary and final plat of Rhoad's Addition to Brown Loop Road (2 lots, Brown Loop Road North, District 2).

AND

preliminary and final plat of Collins Place (2 lots, Highway 188 and Ramsey Road Extension, District 3), requested by the Engineering Department.

- 4) AUTHORIZE advertising and receiving bids for MCP-001-24 / RA49-05-25, Gulfcrest Road Bridge (#177) Rehabilitation, requested by the Engineering Department.
- 5) ACCEPT request of High Purity Silicon America Corporation, along with a petition signed by Evonik and the Alabama State Port Authority to change the name of Mitsubishi Lane.

AND

Adopt a resolution formally changing the name of said segment to Polysilicon Lane for approximately 6,259 feet beginning at the end of Evonik Road and continuing to the municipal limits of the City of Mobile, requested by the Engineering Department.
