All bidders shall furnish a five percent (5%) bid bond on any contract exceeding \$30,000.00: provided that bonding is available for services, equipment or materials. Bid bond will be accepted in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or postal money order, etc.

Out of State Corporations shall furnish a Certificate of Authority to transact business in the State of Alabama. Out of State limited liability companies shall furnish proof of registration to transact business in this state. Alabama law requires that a successful bidder, if it has employees in the State of Alabama, provide proof of enrollment in E-Verify prior to the award of a contract. (See enclosed notice which must be completed, signed and returned with your bid.)

JAMES T. STRICKLAND YOUTH CENTER RESIDENT UNIFORM SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. The County of Mobile reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive all formalities. The County also reserves the right to cancel the contract at any time the service or products prove unsatisfactory in the opinion of the Mobile County Commission.
- 2. The award of this contract will be made to one (1) bidder, considering however that he is the low formal responsible bidder as determined by the Youth Center and Mobile County Commission.
- 3. The successful bidder must guarantee that all garments will fit to the satisfaction of the James T. Strickland Youth Center staff. Garments, which in the judgment of the Director or his authorized representative that do not fit or otherwise fail to meet the specifications will be rejected. Any such uniforms so rejected must be replaced by suitable garments within three (3) weeks or suitable garments will be purchased on the open market and the purchase price thereof will be deducted from the contract amount due the successful bidder.

NOTE: THIS CONTRACT IS FOR THREE (3) YEARS.

QUANTITY AND QUALITY

- 4. All garments must conform to the attached specifications in all respects. All bidders are directed to take special note of the rigid requirements of these specifications as to style and workmanship.
- 5. Any deviation without the express permission of the James T. Strickland Youth Center or Mobile County Commission in writing will be cause for canceling the entire contract.
- 6. The Youth Center can inspect both the manufacturing and storing facilities of the successful bidder.
- 7. It is understood and agreed between the parties hereto that the source of the supply of the material for uniforms furnished by the supplier will comply with sections of the specifications relating thereto, which are made a part thereof, and supplier will not change source of supply without prior approval of the Mobile County Commission.
- 8. The violation of any of the provisions of this contract or any of the obligations herein contained will, at the option of the County of Mobile, constitute a breach of the same and entitles the County to forfeit any rights of the supplier hereunder.
- 9. Supplier will not sell, assign, transfer, or convey any of its rights in the contract except with the written consent of the County of Mobile.
- 10. In case of conflict in the language of specifications and this contract, the terms and conditions of the contract will be final and binding on both parties hereto.

- 11. The Youth Center reserves the right to reject uniforms which do not comply with these specifications, and will suggest any alterations as to fit which it deems necessary. The Director, or appointed representative must approve all fittings. Local operational facility for fitting and alterations must be available.
- 12. The supplier of uniforms will bill the Youth Center, for articles of uniform clothing which are purchased by, delivered to, and accepted by the Youth Center.
- 13. In the event the supplier is unable to provide articles of uniforms in accordance with this contract because materials are unavailable due to war, national emergency, or strikes, then supplier shall not be liable for any damage for failure to deliver, or delay in delivery, directly attributed to such cause. In such event, supplier shall immediately notify the James T. Strickland Youth Center or the Mobile County Commission.

OR EQUAL BIDDING

Specifications regarding the materials and construction of the uniform articles described herein have been written in the best interest of the James T. Strickland Youth Center. This is to insure quality and workmanship in all uniforms supplied by bidders will be consistent. However, a bidder may offer another uniform article for consideration as "equal" only if, prior to the bid opening, written approval is given by the Youth Center and Mobile County Commission. If a bidder fails to name a substitute, he will be required to furnish all items exactly as specified in the specifications.

JAMES T. STRICKLAND YOUTH CENTER RESIDENT UNIFORM SPECIFICATIONS

Shoes:

Low-top Canvas Shoes with Velcro Closures. Non-metal loopholes. Canvas Uppers, Full cushion insoles. Vulcanized rubber shoes. Non-marking soles. Low-tops. Color <u>orange with white</u> bottom, available in sizes 6-13 and 14-17. (Sample of Shoe to be submitted with bid.)

Trousers:

Navy Trousers 3 needle felling stitching, 65% polyester 35% Cotton with a minimum weight of 7.5 oz. Mock fly, bleach resistant to withstand industrial laundry. Hemmed bottoms, no pockets with color coded size labels. Heavy duty polyester thread cotton wrapped. Elastic waistband with at least 4 rows of expansion stitching to allow for maximum give. Elastic should withstand boiling temperatures of 260 degrees for up to four hours. Fabric should be ironclad in order to resist creases. Sizes small to 6X. (Sample of Trousers to be submitted with bid.)

T-Shirts:

Russell T-Shirts, 5.5 oz, First Quality Material. Heavyweight Blend, 50% cotton, 50% Polyester, Color **Orange**. Double stitch at shoulder, sleeves and waist. Available in sizes small to 5X. (Sample of T-Shirt to be submitted with bid.)

Gym Shorts:

Slip on elastic waist gym shorts with mock fly. Color navy available sizes Small to 6X. elastic to be spun yarn woven 1½" heat resistant (26) twenty-six gauge rubber. Serged and double needle lock stitiched to pants (chain stitching is not acceptable). Elastic to be guaranteed for the life of the garment from losing its elasticity. Labels to be woven polyester 2 1/2 "x 1 ½" color coded by size. All seams (3) three felled. Crotch/mock fly to be sew serged, double needle lock stitched and bartacked. Leg hem double folded and lock stitched. Fabric to be 7½ oz. Twill 65% polyester, 35% combed cotton equal to Graniteville 20/20 twill industrial laundry grade fabric. Thread to be the same color as the fabric. All (3) three needle seems shall be cleanly finished and have no raw or frayed edges. (Sample of gym shorts to be submitted with bid.)

Sweatshirts:

Long Sleeve crew neck pullover. Grey color, 50% cotton, 50% polyester, Raglan Sleeves, Crew Neck, Ribbed Knit Collar and Waistband. Available Sizes Small — 5X

Stenciling:

"SYC" is to be stenciled on **all** garments. 2" block letters on shorts and 2" vertical on left pant leg of trousers between the waist and knee; 6" block letters on back of t-shirts and sweatshirts.

Jumpsuits:

Navy jumpsuit raglan with short sleeves with no pockets. Elastic back with spun yarn woven heat resistant 1 ½ elastic. Coverall to be joined at waist with 3 (three) needle fell seam. Six snap front to be size (24) twenty-four line solid brass nickel-plated guaranteed not to rust. (stainless steel snaps and grippers not acceptable). Crotch to be (3) needle stitched and have (2) two bartacks. Lapel to extend to raglan sleeve seam and be bartacked where collar, lapel and raglan seam meet. Thread to be the

same color as the fabric. Labels to be woven polyester ($2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{4}$ ") color coded by size. Fabric to be $7\frac{1}{2}$ oz. Twill -65% polyester, 35% combed cotton equal to Graniteville 20/20 twill industrial grade fabric. All 3 (three) needle seams shall be cleanly finished and have no raw or frayed edges. Available in sizes small -6xlarge. (Sample of Coverall to be submitted with bid.)

Brief-style panties, solid color- brown, available in sizes 5-12

Boxers:

Solid color- brown, available in sizes small – 6XL

Socks:

Solid color white - ankle or low-cut socks men and women

Bras:

Sports bra color- brown, available in sizes 32-44
