

MOBILE COUNTY DOWN PAYMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM



Program Overview

Up to \$25,000 in assistance is available to qualified individuals/households towards the purchase of a single family dwelling located within the designated Mobile County area. Household income must be 80% or less of the current median family income for Mobile County. The minimum amount of assistance provided is \$1,000.

Income Requirements

Applicant Requirements

Must meet one of the following:

- First-time homebuyers
- Those who have not owned a home in the past three (3) years.
- Single parents who have become divorced within the past three (3) years.
- Persons who are citizens of the United States or qualified aliens eligible to receive federal benefits under the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (PRWORA).

Program Details

- Pre-approval by a qualified lender
- Interest-free deferred loan forgiven. over a period of up to ten (10) years.
- Homebuyer must maintain home as their primary residence.
- Homebuyer Counseling

Primary Loan Expectations

- The loan must be a "Qualified Mortgage" under the requirements of the Consumer Protection Financial Bureau (CFPB) outlined at 12 CFR 1026.43 (e).
- Lending products should be fully amortizing 30-year fixed-rate loans.
- USDA up to 33-year fixed rate loan.

Eligible Property Types

- Single-family dwelling unit located within Mobile County designated municipalities & unincorporated areas:
 - Bayou La Batre
 - Chickasaw
 - Citronelle
 - Saraland
 - Semmes
 - Creola
 - Mount Vernon
 - Prichard
 - Satsuma
- Property that is owner-occupied purchaser-occupied or vacant.
