## Optional Parvovirus Testing

Parvovirus is a very contagious and often fatal disease. Animals may be infected 30 days or more before symptoms are observed. Please be aware that the Animal, although apparently healthy, could be infected. Testing for parvovirus is not 100% accurate but, at your option, the Animal can be tested for parvovirus by a veterinarian. The Mobile County Animal Shelter will deliver the Animal to a veterinarian for parvovirus testing and will identify you as its Adopter. You must pick your animal up at the time and place noted at the bottom of this page.

The cost is \$30.00, which is in **addition** to the adoption fee and cannot be refunded. If the Animal is to be spayed or neutered and vaccinated, parvovirus testing will be completed first. If test results are positive and you no longer wish to adopt the Animal, sterilization and vaccination fees will be refunded, or may be applied to another Animal you wish to adopt.
