


Workday Project Recap

- Mobile County successfully completed Workday Financials Implementation in 2022.
- Currently transitioning key Human Capital (HR/Payroll) processes to Workday, a single unified, enterprise cloud-based software system for human capital, payroll, and financial management functions.
- Targeted go live for HR/Payroll Implementation: Summer 2023

- 4. End User Training is projected to begin in June locations and dates TBA


